St. Johns County Watering Restrictions & Water Saving Ideas

New mandatory lawn watering restrictions specify the days you may water. These days depend on whether you have an odd or even numbered address, and the time of the year.

A properly-programmed automatic system can help you meet these requirements. Our technicians can also assess your system and recommend water-saving enhancements that can lower your overall water use.

(Note: information correct as of 3/2009, subject to revision by local authorities)

Time of Year	Residence – Odd Number Address	Residence – Even Number Address	Non Residential Properties
Daylight Savings Time	Water on Wednesday & Saturday	Water on Thursday and Sunday	Water on Tuesday and Friday
Eastern Standard Time	Water Saturday	Water Sunday	Water Tuesday

- Water only when needed and not between 10 AM and 4 PM
- Water for the appropriate time for each zone. Different sprinkler and drip equipment requires different application rates. Ask our experts to help you program your controller for optimum results.
- Restrictions apply to private wells and pumps, ground or surface water, and water from public and private utilities.
- Some exceptions apply.

Water Saving Ideas – Go Green & Reduce Your Water Bill

- Install rain sensor device to eliminate watering during wet weather. Required by state law on all new systems.
- Replace leaking heads and leaking seals in existing heads.
- Repair broken pipes and risers.
- Program control timers properly.
- Upgrade timer to high-efficiency unit.
